Our specialist library staff can assist you with discovering information that is relevant and useful to your particular needs, and advice on building your research, information and digital literacy skills.

## **Print collection**

The library holds specialist collections relating to nursing and midwifery practice, education, history and working conditions. We have textbooks and clinical materials to support Diploma and Bachelor of Nursing/Midwifery students. Loans are 14 days and members are welcome to borrow up to six items at one time.

## **Electronic books and databases**

Thousands of authoritative, peer-reviewed journals are available through Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature (CINAHL) (available online through the Member Menu on our website) and ProQuest (Nursing and Allied Health) databases (available on site).
