EBA ballot closure date extended to 4 November 2016

ANMF recommends you vote YES today

The Elections Australia electronic ballot to approve the new Victorian public sector nurses and midwives enterprise agreement opened on 17 October.

The ballot has been extended and will now close on Friday 4 November.

ANMF is aware that the ballot has been delayed in several workplaces due to employers not providing the agreement, summary of key changes and voting information to all eligible employees at least seven days prior to the start of the ballot as required by the Fair Work Act.
