Please find the below resolution passed by Bolton Clarke ANMF NSW Branch members, who met on 22 July 2024.

Resolution: Passed Unanimously

ANMF NSW Branch members working at Bolton Clarke express their solidarity with ANMF Victoria Branch members taking Protected Industrial Action and condemn the company's measly 2% pay offer and reported threatened lockout of union nurses.

Bolton Clarke's approach in this dispute is heartless and NSW Bolton Clarke nurses can see what's ahead in bargaining for our new NSW Agreement. We know in NSW Bolton Clarke has already proposed cuts to future pay and working conditions. Like our fellow nurses in Victoria, we will stand up for what's fair and safe for us and residents.

We call on Chief Executive Officer Steven Muggleton to meet the reasonable demands of the ANMF Victoria Branch, withdraw its proposed cuts and provide a decent and fair pay offer along with safe staffing in NSW. Thaw your frozen heart Bolton Clarke.
